Courses Offered

A brief profile of the College

Situated in North Lakhimpur town in the north bank of Brahmaputra, Lakhimpur Girls' College was established on the 16th of August, 1972 with only Arts stream. Pioneering women's education for around five decades, the college takes pride in working for the holistic development of the students as well as inculcating in them a sense of dignity and self-confidence. Located in the Khelmati area of North Lakhimpur, the college is affiliated to Dibrugarh University and Assam Higher Secondary Education Council. The inauguration of the Science stream in the 1990 was another milestone in the history of the institution. Consisting of 57 faculty members and 28 non-teaching staff, the college has a student strength of One Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty Nine students. In the current year, 925 students have taken admission in B.A and 370 students in B.Sc. In Higher Secondary course, 418 students are admitted in Arts stream and 116 in Science stream.

One of the premiere institutions of women's education, the college has been offering opportunities to girls aspiring for higher education since last six years in the north bank of Brahmaputra. The department is a pioneer in the entire north-east to have started this course next to Assam Agricultural University, Jorhat.

Infrastructural Accessibilities

The College is equipped with certain modern infrastructural facilities to ensure that the students have access to an environment for their all-round development.

- **DIGITAL CLASSROOM :** In order to meet the demands of changing technology, the college provides a well-furnished digital classroom with the necessary IT based teaching aids. The digital video projector also enables screening of cinemas required in various disciplines.
- **LANGUAGE LAB :** Lakhimpur Girls' College has a well-equipped language lab for students to carry on various activities in order to enhance their linguistic knowledge. Completed in the year 2020, the lab possesses adequate computer facilities.
- **COMPUTER LAB :** In order to carry out various innovative and scientific experiments, the college has a computer lab with 20 computers along with a generator for uninterrupted experiments.
- **LECTURE HALL :** To ensure 100 percent accommodation of students, there are two well-furnished lecture halls in the new RCC building with the capacity of 200 students.
- **CONFERENCE HALL :** The conference hall in the Science Block facilitates a favourable

environment for various lectures, meetings and conferences or seminars.

- **LIBRARY :** A good library is an indispensable part of any educational institution. That serves the needs of both students and faculties. Lakhimpur Girls' College has recently completed the renovation of the digital library which is efficiently maintained with a computerized data-filling system. It consists of a good number of books. New books have been added through the course of each academic year.
- **GYMNASIUM :** With the minimum necessary equipment, the college also provides a gymnasium for the students to carry on various activities for physical health including yoga classes.
- **INDOOR STADIUM :** The indoor stadium also caters to the needs of the students who aspire for sports activities.
- **ASTHA :** PRE-SCHOOL CUM DAY-CARE CENTER: The college has a day-care centre for the wards of the college staffs. The centre is under the supervision of the department of Home Science and is well equipped with facilities and infrastructure for kids.

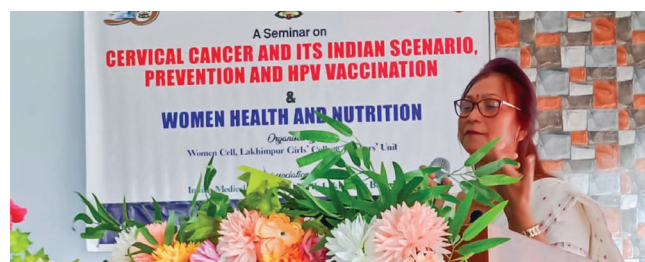

- On the occasion of World Philosophy Day, the department organized a discussion with the theme “Philosophy: Bridging Social Gaps” on 21st November 2024.



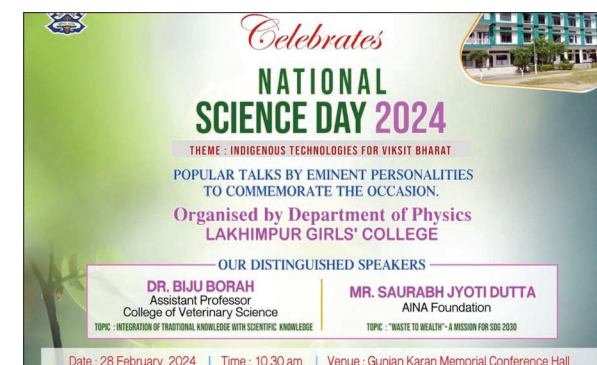
DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE
